About Westport, CT


- Approximately 27,000 residents

- Parks and Recreation and Public Works Departments present the most opportunities for vendors


Why do Business with Westport








You must register to download bids & get updates

- Introduce yourself to Procurement Officer for projects \$25,000 or less
- Meet the insurance requirements
- Occasional project walk-through
