Westport Police Assist MTA Police and Amtrak Police

The Westport Police Department was contacted at approximately 7:30pm on the evening of Sunday March 18, 2018 by the Metropolitan Transit Authority requesting assistance with a suspicious person investigation. This investigation was undertaken in response to a complaint phoned into the MTA Police and ultimately handled in conjunction with the Amtrak Police Department as it was found to be connected with one of their trains. This investigation necessitated a brief closure of Greens Farms Railroad Station to vehicular and pedestrian traffic by the Westport Police Department. At approximately 9:15pm, based on the information communicated by the investigating agencies, the area was re-opened to all traffic. At this time there is no on-going threat to public safety or cause for any further concern relative to this matter.
