2. WestPAC update. Kathie

Friends of WestPAC held an exhibition and auction fund raiser on June 7th at Rive Bistro. This was the second event for Friends of West PAC. Amount raised is not in yet, but looking ahead: a stronger committee is needed to make the event grow.

Westport Schools calendar art has been selected from 196 entries.

This coming years WestPAC budget will be funded from PTA and Friends, with help from WAAC. A \$1,500 grant from Friends will go to the social Studies department who use the Town Art collection as part of the curriculum.

Help is still needed to catalog the collection. Louise DeMakis was suggested.

(Kathie also needs help processing more than 60 works of art offered to the Town as donations. WAAC may be able to provide funds to hire someone.)

3. TEA Talk, October 21, 2018, confirmed

Two titles for the program were put forward;

Event would focus around the creation of art, the sharing of art, and the usage of art as perceived by millennials and younger.
