FINAL MINUTES

RACQUETS ADVISORY COMMITTEE - WESTPORT PARKS & RECREATION

1. Call to Order: 7:36 PM

This was the thirteenth regular meeting of the Racquets Advisory Committee (RAC), held in Room 212D at Town Hall, Westport, CT.

4. Parks and Recreation Department Update

- Longshore Tennis
 - o Courts 1-5 are planned to open on May 5th. Courts 6-7 and 8-9 may open earlier.
 - There are a few maintenance items carrying over from last season, such as poor drainage at Courts 8-9; David to email P&R Director.

Pickleball

- o One Westport Pickleball enthusiast was present to participate in the discussions.
- Pickleball at Compo Beach has been added to the Chelsea Reservation System. Additionally, signage will be posted
 at the court that will clearly display blocked time slots (for Clinics), similar to those posted at the Longshore
 Platform Tennis courts.
- Clinics begin the second week of May
- Maintenance: Compo Beach courts will be resurfaced at the end of April; drifting perimeter sand will be contained (wind-driven sand excepted); two picnic tables with umbrellas will be placed near the court.
- It was agreed that the lines for the two Pickleball courts at Doubleday would be relocated. Two Pickleball courts will now be lined (in yellow) on either side of the net of the furthest Tennis court; the Tennis net will remain in place and function as a "wall" between the two Pickleball courts; the "kitchen" will not be painted in. Players will bring their own nets.
- o No other sites have been identified as available for outdoor play
- Tennis at other locations: Town Farm, Staples and Doubleday (outside of school hours) are open
