### LEGAL NOTICE OF DECISION

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting held on September 05, 2018, the Westport Flood & Erosion Control Board took the following actions:

1. **14 Allen Raymond Lane/ Application WPL #10660-18; APPROVED;** Application of LandTech, on behalf of the owners Young Mens Christian Association & Westport/Weston Conn Inc., for the demolition of a house and shed, replacement of the amphitheater, replacement of a section of boardwalk and construction of a waterfront overlook platform with canoe storage within the WPLO. The proposed activity is within the WPL area for Poplar Plains Brook and the Saugatuck River.
2. **15 Old Mill Road/ Application WPL #10649-18; APPROVED;** Application of Barr Associates LLC and Peter Cadoux Architects, on behalf of the owner, Deer Lake LLC, for the construction of a new main residence and driveway modification and associated site appurtenances within the WPLO. The proposed activity is within the WPL area for the Sherwood Mill Pond.
3. **52 Harbor Road/ Application WPL #10664-18; APPROVED;** Application of Barr Associates, LLC, on behalf of the owner, Joshua Frank for the construction of a new single family residence, spa, patio and driveway and associated site appurtenances within the WPLO. The proposed activity is within the WPL area for the Saugatuck River.
4. **25 Oak Ridge Park/ Application WPL #10650-18; APPROVED;** Application of Barr Associates, LLC, on behalf of the owner, Debra Kowalsky to maintain the existing dock, pool, pool patio and storage garage; remove the existing shed and deck; and construct a new single family residence with driveway, pool equipment pad and associated site appurtenances, and within the WPLO. The proposed activity is within the WPL area for the Saugatuck River.
