I. Other Business:

II. TEA Talk:

Discussion of the October 21 TEA Talk, The Arts Go Viral! ensued.

The panel was finalized. Moderated by David Pogue, it will include Frederic Chiu and his work with Disklavier; Jerry Goehring, producer of *Be More Chill*; and a representative of WestPAC who will present the Collections through Otocast.
