## 1.New Member Update:

- a. Leonor from Collective has joined us today

- 2.Calendar Sales update from Ive: Essentially SOLD OUT! We've had great feedback, more than 150 sold on Back To School nights. Showcasing the video was helpful as a sales tactic.
- 3. Site updates: URGENT: need to find storage space as Staples Closet is overflowing, particularly with the addition of all the rescued CMS (undamaged) works.
  - a. Coleytown Middle School Mold update:
    - repair estimates for damaged works insurance will pay for everything.
      Kathie is working to schedule this work going forward. Jennifer may help out at BMS since CMS is out of commission.
    - ii. CMS will need to be cleared of rest of undamaged works in November.

### b. Staples High School

#### c. Senior Center

- New SC building to open in January. Start the process of selecting art in Mid Nov. Current inventory is in the attic, maybe accessible in December. A new additional display space is available - a permanent corner with signage.

- 4.TEA Talk: art going viral. Randa will be giving powerpoint presentation including "what is WestPAC" video at 2pm Sunday Oct 21st. David Pogue will be hosting; Dan Woog will promote as well.
- 5.Status of Data Entry Project: Tiffany has finished all new accessions that were backlogged. Next step is to forward to School and Town for approvals. As she has more time she is working on correcting prior accessions errors in the entries. We plan to get more money from Friends for more archival work. Bios look great.
- 6.Investigation of more sites for designated WestPAC art: looking at Staples, at Senior Center for a new nook, and at Westport Country Playhouse.
