DHS Staff Report & Updates, Elaine Daignault

- Center for Senior Activities Enhancement Update the project is on time and on budget. WCSA continues to raise funds for specific needs that are not covered under the renovations. Examples include: gym equipment and kitchen supplies
- DHS continues to pursue opportunities to serve at risk residents during times of emergency.
 The Fire Department is moving to NIXLE that will provide a better system for outreach via the automated system.

 - Discussion of commissioners' role as advocates for residents and advisors to DHS.
 - O Public meetings have historically had a guest speaker on a topic of interest, followed by staff reports and updates on current projects throughout town.  - Priorities and future focus on advocacy, education and monitoring town/federal trends as it pertains to DHS programs and services

 A follow up meeting will be planned with Jeff Weiser of Homes with Hope to discuss Affordable Housing processes with the intent of clarifying availability and potential of increased access.
