**Town of Westport
Parks Advisory Committee
Final Minutes
December 17, 2018**

The Parks Advisory Committee of the town of Westport met in Room 309 of Town Hall on Monday, December 17, 2018. Chairman David Floyd called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Members present: Nat Brogadir, John Connell, JoAnn Davidson, Rob Feakins, John Lovro, David New, and Rob Wolter.

Members Absent: Jennifer Weil.

- 1. Approval of Minutes** – The minutes of the November 19, 2018 meeting were unanimously approved.
- 2. Comments** – Riverside Park: Jen Fava and Bruce Lindsey recently met with Town officials in reviewing wetlands setbacks. In some areas, the setbacks will need to be staked prior to plans for making improvements to the park. Barons South: ribbon cutting for the additions to the Senior Center are set for 1/4/2019.
- 3. Parks Advisory Committee Meeting Dates – 2019** – Dates attached to the Agenda were unanimously approved, noting that the meeting for 1/28/2019 was previously approved.
- 4. Annual Clean Up Day** – The Committee agreed to target April 13, 2019 as the date, subject to the actual timing of the Town's 'Green Up Day'. Subsequent to the meeting, Parks & Recreation checked with the Town's Conservation Department who said that Earthplace, who usually hosts Green Day, indicated there will be not be an 'assigned' Green Day. Rather, they will look to include Green Day with the Maker's Faire on Saturday, April 27, 2019
- 5. Library Riverwalk – Poison Ivy Infestation** – David Floyd described the concerns outlined the email received from Dick Lowenstein regarding infestation of poison ivy along the Library Riverwalk. Jen Fava indicated the Parks and Recreation Department is already identifying problem areas and will eradicate.

Motion was made to adjourn and passed unanimously. Chairman Floyd adjourned the meeting.
