Might be possible to set up some WestPAC features on easels in the cafeteria reception area.... Hope to possibly put a WestPAC presentation up on the tv monitors during the event.

7.Friends issues:

A.Project Calendar: The calendar and its improved success last year was discussed by Friends - they would like to boost school participation this year and will coordinate with art teachers. Friends has volunteered to help students make digital submissions. Suggestion to have a poster advertising the calendar for kids to submit.

B.Drew Friedman Foundation - Friends money for curriculum work. This needs to be brought up at next Friends meeting. Tom might be able to help promote this to staff... Kathie will send Tom all details.

8. Site Representative Reports:

A.KHS: Inna and Randa are working on the Art Smart Museum Night in May - hope to gain more WestPAC exposure, hopefully utilizing the tv monitors with WestPAC video clip.

B.LLS: Have 2 Art Smart projects using our works; Rehanging works in the Kindergarten hallway; Annie Exhibition is ready to go in time with the Show - and got approval to keep using the Annie Exhibition spot to become a "teaching gallery" to rotate more WestPAC works

C.CES: Rescued some works that were getting light exposure; with conferences coming up, Scott hopes to hang some more of our works to raise awareness as parents will be walking around the building.

D.BMS: Museum Night (as detailed above) in May, Jen will work with art teachers, see about getting our video clip on the tv monitors for that night.

E.GFS: need follow up to get a recruit in place to take on this site.

F.SES: Imke needs more help

G.Town Hall: rotating art in places, desperately need more manpower!

H.Senior Center: Einsel shadow boxes from the SHS closet will get hung in the Game Room - Kathie will circulate SignUp Genius to get member help to hang.; They have requested an education talk on the Collection; New hanging artwork needs labels - may see about getting some of the seniors to help out with this.

9.Additional items for review:

A. Howard Abel Connections: 8 pieces identified to donate to our collection - Westport artists. Kathie is facilitating these works going thru our process.

B.BEFORE JUNE 30th: WestPAC will have to do end of year report for renewing our 3 year stewardship of the Collection. We'd like to propose a longer stewardship than 3 years. Need to focus on this at our next meeting.
