APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENTAL SANITARY SEWER CONNECTION AT PROPERTY KNOWN AS 1 RIVARD CRESCENT, CONTINGENT UPON COMPLIANCE WITH THE WPCA COORDINATOR'S LETTER OF JUNE 8, 2011
