DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Please make sure you drop off and pick up your child promptly. Consistent lateness in either dropping off or picking up is cause for dismissal from the basketball program. If you choose to stay for the program you might have to sit on the floor or if this option is not available due to space restrictions, be asked to stay in the cafeteria. This gym is very small, and safety is our main concern when the children are playing.

GENERAL RULES

- All participants are expected to respect each other and all staff. Discipline problems will not be tolerated are cause for immediate dismissal from the program with no refund.
