WESTPORT HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Westport Historic District Commission will hold a Public Hearing at **7:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday, September 8, 2020** to hear:

1. A *Certificate of Appropriateness* application dated August 11, 2020 to build two fences and paint the house at **1 Evergreen Parkway** located in the Evergreen Avenue Local Historic District.
2. A *Certificate of Appropriateness* application dated July 6, 2020 to build a 95 unit Assisted Living and Memory Care residence, move the house at **174 Post Road West**, demolish the house now situated at **172 Post Road West** and create parking lots and driveways associated with egress located in the Kings Highway North Local Historic District.
