Improvements to Christ and Holy Church Property at 59 Myrtle Avenue

HIGH LEVEL GOALS:

Restore integrity to the building with architecturally like replacement windows and elimination of aluminum storm windows (ca. 1960's), carpentry work on the rear porch (our main entrance) for safety and a fresh exterior paint job.

WINDOWS:

The windows at 59 Myrtle Avenue, have original double hung wood single pane, with brass sash locks, without mutins and have exterior storm windows as shown on the attached photos. Our intention is to replace the windows on the first and second floors with W-2500 Jeld-wen wood double hung windows (or comparable) which are clad with white vinyl on the outside for easier maintenance and wood painted on the inside with an antique brass sash lock. The new windows would match the existing traditional windows in style, with no grills between the glass. The existing interior and exterior trim would be kept as much as possible, only replacing anything that is rotted or breaks during replacement. The existing windows with diamond pattern in the attic dormers and the decorative window on the front porch with diamond pattern will remain original and untouched.

EXTERIOR PAINTING

The existing clapboard and shingles are currently peeling and it is estimated that the existing paint is approximately 10-15 years old. The plan is to powerwash, scrape and sand to allow adherence of new quality paint, which will match the existing colors.

REAR PORCH:


The rear porch has a metal pipe handrail which does not meet the current building code and the boards on the floor of the porch are soft. The plan is to replace the porch floor with the same width cedar boards, and to replace the metal handrail with a wood one that meets code and correlates with the existing railing on the west side of the rear porch. Afterward a new coat of Benjamin Moore Low Lustre Platinum Gray porch paint will be applied to the porch and stairs, and railing will be painted, as noted above for exterior trim paint.
















