- 1. Independent living with services
- 2. Long Term Care/Rehabilitative Short Term

The RFP will be broad enough so as not to keep any developers from participating. There will be certain basic services such as transportation. It is a matter of access to services, not providing services. There is reference to a care coordinator being knowledgeable of services in the community. Focus on independence meaning independent choices. There is a core objective to serving the community at large. We discussed the need for the developers to demonstrate qualifications to develop phase 2. Revisions to the RFP will be made based on our discussions.
