- Minimize programmatic changes
- WIN periods and small groups during instructional blocks
- Provide students with longer recess time
- Return to an hour math period daily
- Add a library and technology period to K-2 schedules
- Time for staff collaboration

Special Areas





- 30 minute periods for special areas
- Art remains 60 minutes
- Addition of K-2 ITL period
- Addition of P.E. period in grades 3-5

Literacy, Math, Science & Social Studies





- Math: 45 minutes in Kindergarten, 60 minutes in Gr 1-5
- Literacy: Between 90-120 minutes daily
- Science/SS: 90 minutes a week

Lunch & Recess





- 30 minute lunch and recess daily
- Can be split apart to create opportunities for social breaks throughout the day
