ABBREVIATED ACTION MINUTES

The Westport Historic District Commission held a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 12, 2013 in Town Hall Room 201.

PUBLIC HEARING

- 1. To elect Historic District Commission officers for the year 2013. Without the required quorum of five full members, there was no election of officers. Postponed until the April 9, 2013 public hearing.
- 2. To hear Chairman's report and update on current HDC activities. Chair Henkels updated the members on the Gunn House project and the preparation of a draft RFP for proposed developer to purchase the structure on town property.
- 3. To approve the minutes of the February 12, 2013 public hearing. **The minutes were approved as amended.**
- 4. To review comments made by the Planning and Zoning Commission and State Historic Preservation Office on the study report for proposed local historic designation at <u>25 Avery Place</u>. Letters of support with no comments or recommendations from SHPO and P&Z Commission were read into the record. It was the consensus among the members that the name of the barn will be changed to read the "Bradley-Wheeler House and Cobblestone Barn" from this point forward. The final report will be approved with the support of the property owner at the April HDC public hearing.
- 5. To take such action as the meeting may determine to approve a *Certificate of Appropriateness Application* for proposed exterior changes to a barn at <u>57 Wright Street</u> located in the Kings Highway North Historic District. The application was withdrawn by the applicant in order to come back with drawings that match the proposed specs. No action was taken.
- 6. To take such action as the meeting may determine to approve a *Certificate of Appropriateness Application* for private driveway signage at 5, 5A, 5B, 5C, 5D and 5E Gorham Avenue located in the Gorham Avenue Historic District. Withdrawn by the applicant. No action was taken.
- 7. To take such action as the meeting may determine to approve a *Certificate of Appropriateness Application* for proposed installation of solar panels, installation of an electric vehicle charging station, and installation of a sign at the charging station for public notice at <u>61 Jesup Road</u> located in the Jesup Road Historic District. **Unanimously approved.**
- 8. To take such action as the meeting may determine to approve a *Certificate of Appropriateness Application* for proposed installation of a generator at Old Town Hall, **90 Post Road East** located in the Jesup Road Historic District. **The application was withdrawn by the applicant for modifications.**
- 9. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of delay for a demolition permit application at 10 Harding Lane. Unanimously approved to waive the delay.
- 10. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of delay for a demolition permit application at <u>3 Bluewater Hill</u>. **Unanimously approved waiving the delay.**
- 11. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of delay for a demolition permit application at **3 Rustic Lane**. **Unanimously approved waiving the delay.**

- 12. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of delay for a demolition permit application at <u>25 Norwalk Avenue</u>. Unanimously opposed waiving the delay.
- 13. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of delay for a demolition permit application at <u>17 Dogwood Lane</u>. <u>Unanimously approved waiving the delay</u>.
- 14. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of delay for a demolition permit application at <u>95 Bayberry Lane</u>. Unanimously approved waiving the delay.
