Text Amendment #791: Appl. #PZ-21-00211 submitted by the Planning and Zoning Commission to modify Section 11-2.4, Permitted Accessory Building, Structures and Uses, to allow Accessory Dwelling Units in detached structures with associated zoning standards, Section 11-2.4.12A, Accessory Apartment, to increase allowable floor area and to remove requirement for Annual Certification. Language is proposed to be removed limiting any accessory building or structure to 300 SF in size, one-story in height, or limited to two water use fixtures.
