Course

Several years ago XGD Greens Drainage Systems were installed on greens 2 and 6. It has made significant improvement to those greens. At this time we are looking to install the same type of XGD Greens Drainage System to the remaining 16 greens.

The installation efforts are planned for the fall of 2022 as fall is the suggested time to do this work. This will need to be bid out through the formal bid process and we are aware of significant delays on delivery of materials so we are looking to start this process now.

Anticipated Cost:

\$195,000

Lifespan:

20-25 years

Annual Payback Over 20 Years (estimated):

\$11,320

This project is included in the Parks and Recreation Department's 5-Year Capital plan for FY21/22.

Payback for this project was anticipated when golf fees were raised prior to the current season and will cover the annual debt service.

Therefore it is requested that the Parks and Recreation Commission supports moving forward with the appropriation process in the amount of \$195,000.00.
