  - ♦ Public outreach with stakeholders, including and Advisory Committee, general public meetings, small stakeholder meetings with select groups and drop-in sessions.
  - ♦ Identification of Alternatives
  - ♦ Development of Recommendations
  - ♦ Implementation, Draft and Final Plans
- Establishing a timeline for the information meetings and fact gathering meetings
- > Suggestions were offered by the Directors on outreach and reporting on progress
- The interface with the Rail Parking Study was also discussed.
