- Connect people at home, provide good, nutritious meals.

- WCSA delivered meals to homebound/Home Delivered Meal recipients on Christmas eve, partially supported by the Westport Women's Club

Elaine D., - Woman's Club also worked with DHS to offer individuals and families in need by offering grocery Gift Cards to DHS clients with financial hardships.

- **Westport Warm-up Fund** helps with home heating needs for residents who qualify under the state/federal/local income criteria.
- Please refer residents to Human Services (DHS) if they require resources or assistance.

Transportation: Continues to be a priority topic for CPD

Elaine explained that certain programs like Door to Door will continue to be offered; the Commuter Shuttle provides an important services. COVID has negatively affected ridership. There may be new options available in the future including a pilot program called Riders Choice currently testing in Norwalk Transit - Peter Gold is the Westport Transit Director.

Door-to-Door – requires pre-registration before utilizing the services, requiring 24 hour notice for rides.
