## 1, Recap ARP Funding

Nancy and Lee reported on the Jan 5 Board of Finance (BOF) meeting re: allocations to arts organizations from the ARP grant. Nancy thanked Lee for managing the application process..

Report: After much discussion, the BOF voted unanimously to allocate the full \$200,643 WAAC requested, to be allocated to 12 arts organizations for project funding. The BOF emphasized that programs and services for children and seniors be paramount.

The allocation request now goes to the RTM on February 1<sup>st</sup> at 7:30 on Zoom. As all WAAC members feel that the RTM should vote on the allocation request as one block grant, it was suggested that the committee members contact their RTM members in the district they live and let their views be known. A majority of 19 votes are needed for the bulk allocation to pass. Nancy will send everyone talking points. A quick survey of the committee showed the following districts are covered:

District 2, Nancy and Miggs; District 3, Charles and Richard. District 5, Frederic; District 7, Shobana; District 8; Kathie, Lee, Eric. District 9, Dina Others still need to check their districts.

## 2. MOCA show and WestPAC

Kathie reported that all artworks have been delivered to MOCA on schedule. MOCA has done a great job on press; and a list of WAAC's invitees has been sent to marketing.

Nancy again pointed out how fabulous it is to be showing WestPAC in an annual show.
