 Finding a grant that the town can apply for regarding a tree inventory for the town right-of-way (TROW) and Public Works properties.

Tree Board will work to find grants applicable to Tree Inventory

• Putting together information on how to hire an arborist AND tree work in the TROW needs a permit. Several of the violations that I have been investigating have had work completed by a licensed arborist (no permit). The work however was not to ANSI standards or best management practices. I would like to find a way to educate how to hire an arborist and why it's important as well as the need for a permit. Hopefully, this will help prevent poor pruning. I've also attached a copy of the permit required for tree work in the TROW.

Raised Bill No. 5116 (February session 2022)

Bill to require electrical distribution company to distribute funds to towns to replace trees cut due to vegetation management.

This bill is currently being discussed. Eversource could be required to fund tree planting in the future.
