

Board of Selectwomen Special Meeting
March 14, 2022
APPROVED MINUTES

The Westport Board of Selectwomen held a special meeting on Monday, March 14, 2022, at 11:00 AM. Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order No. 7B, there was no physical location for this meeting. It was held electronically. In attendance were Andrea Moore, Candice Savin, Paul Friia, Eileen Flug and Eileen Francis, recording secretary.

Assessor Paul Friia presented the agenda item. He stated that the proposed alternate member, Tom Bloch, was previously appointed to the Board of Assessment Appeals (BOAA), and his term expired. Mr. Friia explained the purpose for an alternate member and the value they provided to the BOAA. Candice Savin questioned why the Board of Selectwomen made such appointments. Assistant Town Attorney Eileen Flug explained that the State Statute, 9-199 (b), in a municipality with a representative town meeting as the legislative body, provides for the Board of Select(wo)men to make the appointment. The Board had no additional questions. Upon motion by Andrea Moore, seconded by Candice Savin and passing by a vote of 2-0, it was:

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes Sec. 9-199 (b) and upon the recommendation of the Assessor, the appointment of Thomas Bloch as an alternate member to the Westport Board of Assessment Appeals for a term beginning immediately through September 30, 2025 and until his successor is appointed and qualified, is hereby APPROVED.

Upon motion by Candice Savin, seconded by Andrea Moore and passing by a vote of 2-0, the meeting adjourned at 11:10 am.
