- 1. Approved Minutes from Previous Meeting April 13, 2022.
 - Introduction of Gali Katz, prospective new member.

2. Collection Update:

- Inventory and CTCo: nothing new to update
- Subcommittee for Accessions:
 - "Gossip" by Elizabeth Catlett donated by Jilda Manikas was approved by the Board of Selectwomen at their meeting April 27th and has now entered the collection.
 - Review of list of 53 works recommended for declassifying and removal from the collection by accessions subcommittee. These consist of posters and reproductions (not fine art), some works damaged beyond repair, and works that are in the database but not actually in the collection.
 - Discussion of what to do with the works after they are removed from collection. Proposed to find locations where they can be appreciated and/or sold to raise funds for WestPAC
 - Committee voted to approve declassifying the list of works. The list will next be presented to the Westport Arts Advisory Committee, and then eventually to the Board of Selectwomen or Board of Education.
