2. Collection Update:

- CT Collections: training sessions continue. They are making upgrades to the public portal this fall, and we are providing feedback to hopefully improve the site.

 - This year will have a more narrow scope, featuring Paul Camacho pieces from our collection as well as other loaned pieces
 - Discussion about this gallery slot for 2024 onward, how to feature our collection
- Planning for BMS/CMS loan art project: call for submissions has gone out with September 23rd deadline
