APPROVE SUPPLEMENTAL SEWER CONNECTION AT 44 OTTER TRAIL

1. WPCA Collection System Supervisor Bryan Thompson presented WPCA Item #1 (BOS Item #8). Upon motion by Candice Savin, seconded by Andrea Moore, and passing by a vote of 3-0, it was:

RESOLVED, that the supplemental sanitary sewer connection at 44 Otter Trail, contingent upon compliance with the WPCA Collection System Supervisor's letter of September 26, 2022, is hereby APPROVED.

APPROVE SUPPLEMENTAL SEWER CONNECTION AT 159A COMPO ROAD SOUTH
