### 1. Committee Updates

- Approved Minutes from Previous Meeting October 12, 2022.
- Annual report was shared by email with BOS and BOE; Receipt was acknowledged by thank you to committee from BOE - Lee Goldstein; invited to present at BOE, Jan/Feb will piggyback on new accessions and update on all our activities. Kathie suggested also sending the report to RTM LMA (Library, Museum and Arts Committee Chair, Kristin Purcell) and making an appointment to meet with the LMA committee as Randa, Kathie and Nancy had in June. 2020.
- Open Positions -
  - Co-Internship Chair: Anne Boberski provided details of what is needed to manage the SHS spring internship for its 5 week duration May/June.
  - Social Media: Kathie Bennewitz explained what is needed... led to discussion of
    ideas on how to handle this position as a means to publicize the collections and its
    projects and accomplishments, and to address some members' concerns over
    artists rights/use of images. Further discussion will be held in next month's
    meeting to plan how to best strategically employ social media platforms to meet
    our needs.

### 2. Collection Update:

- Kathie Bennewitz reported on the state of the Storage room 2 at SHS. Tasks to clear it up to make a more usable and safe space for *temporary* art storage.
  - Unframing Ford Times collection (logistics involved and to be planned), to be scheduled for after school or day off upcoming; cataloging these fully might be good project for internship in spring
  - $\circ\quad$  Taking works with frame repair needs to Rockwell, or another framer
  - Rehanging Kiermaier work as due to its size it will be safer than in storage; SHS may have potential space for it, possibly Teacher's Lounge

 Walter Einsel, Selectmen Watcher sculpture (#542) needs to be placed back on public views, and removed from Storage 2; needs a new pedestal. Anne suggested that this might be a good project for SHS woodshop/tech classes (she will reach out)

- Town Hall Anne Boberski reported on new Conservation and Operations directors completing reinstalls of art in their offices.
  - Dan Woog 06880 Post Today (11/9/2022) showcased Tom Kiely, new ops director, and included picture with new artwork
- GFS Anne Boberski and Emma Quilhot reported on key reinstalls, including Lou Hicks Playing with Red (#186) and Burt Chernow Gallery reinstallation and Fisher's Revolutionary War posters on 2nd floor
  - o Ive still needs to tackle discussion of rails for 2nd floor w/ facilities
- KHS Gali Katz and Kelcey Hicks reported plans for main office and faculty lounge redesigns; discussion also over entryway at KHS and the problems of security and weather
- CES Stephanie Klose (via Ive) reported that DEI committee request for artworks to feature: committee discussion included Richard Hunt and ideas for others
- SHS Leonor Turut reported
  - English classroom installation completed (minus Daugherty Moses #1918 still to come from framing)
  - Discussion around outdated student artwork hanging (screwed into) on walls and taking up valuable space. Leonor proposed to work with the Art Dept to see about taking down some of this art and replacing it with works from the Collection and new student art
