- 1. November December Programs (with UNA-SW CT)

- The Ruth Steinkraus Cohen Memorial Lecture: The event was very successful
 with approximately 150 in attendance, and more watching via zoom. Thanks to
 Aye Aye and Barbara Jay for finding Mary Evelyn Tucker. The consensus was
 that next year we need to find a speaker earlier. The reception was popular –
 next year we'll need to plan RSVPs better. We discussed possible speakers in
 the political realm, NGO world and UN.
- Weston Town Hall Marge reported a successful event with live music, great participation with students, good turnout.
- Westport Town Hall—Bill reported it was a modest affair. Jen Tooker made a statement, and there were two Staples high school students. We didn't promote the event.
