## ABBREVIATED ACTION MINUTES Westport Historic District Commission Public Hearing July 8, 2014

The Westport Historic District Commission held a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 8, 2014 in Town Hall Room 201 for the following purposes:

- 1. To hear Chairman's report and update on current HDC activities.
  - The first round of proposals for the Minute Man Monument restoration project were too high. However, it was re-bid with a proposal from a very good bidder and below funding amount.
  - The Village District Study is progressing with consultant interviews with stakeholders and working in conjunction with the Downtown Master Plan Committee. The purpose of the proposed establishment of a village district is to simplify zoning and provide design guidelines.
  - The Maplewood Avenue Study Report is completed and n the process of being submitted to the Town Clerk, Planning and Zoning Office, and the State Historic Preservation Office for review and comments.
  - The town has prepared a ground lease for the relocation of the Kemper-Gunn House.
- 2. To approve the minutes of the June 10, 2014 special meeting and public hearing. The minutes of the June 10, 2014 special meeting and public hearing were approved as amended.
- 3. To take such action as the meeting may determine to approve a *Certificate of Appropriateness Application* dated June 25, 2014 for the proposed construction of a garage addition at 7 Washington Avenue located in the Gorham Avenue Historic District. Approved by a vote 4 (yes) Henkels, Gerber, Weingarten and Rafalaf and 1 (no) Wacker.
- 4. To take such action as the meeting may determine to reconsider waiving the balance of the delay period for a demolition permit application at **8 Bradley Street** located in the Compo Owenoke Historic District. **Denied unanimously.**
- 5. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of the delay period for a demolition permit application at **10 Reichert Circle**. **Approved unanimously.**
- 6. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of the delay period for a demolition permit application at **166 Cross Highway.** Approved unanimously.
- 7. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of the delay period for a demolition permit application at **54 North Avenue**, c. 1906, identified on the Historic Resources Inventory. **Denied unanimously.**

- 8. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of the delay period for a demolition permit application at **12 Manitou Road**. **Approved unanimously.**
- 9. To take such action as the meeting may determine to waive the balance of the delay period for a demolition permit application at **19 Hillspoint Road. Approved unanimously.**
- 10. To discuss the definition of demolition as it applies to historic resources. The members created a subcommittee responsible for working with the building official on the HDC's definition of a demolition as it applies to the demolition delay ordinance.
- 11. To discuss possible nominations for the upcoming 2014 Annual Preservation Awards to be announced in the fall. **The members discussed upcoming nominations.**
