1. Approval of Minutes

Upon a motion by Elaine Whitney, seconded by Alec Stevens, the minutes of the Parks and Recreation Commission meeting held on October 19, 2022, were approved 4-0

3. Reports of:

Golf Advisory Committee:

Jane Dally, Chair of the GAC, reported that there was a successful wrap up over the last month, with associations completing play and events. The golf course recovered well from the summer, the greens drainage project was completed, and Brad has a winter maintenance plan in place. The GAC did not hold their December meeting.

Jennifer Fava stated the rounds for November were 1,893, the contract with Brightview was extended three years, and the course is closing for the season on Sunday, December 11, 2022.

Parks Advisory Committee:

David Floyd, Chair of the Parks and Recreation Commission, reported that the last PAC meeting was cancelled. But highlighted that Riverside Park has reopened.

Racquets Advisory Committee:

Ward Doonan, member of the RAC, reported they had a meeting on November 14, 2022. Tennis has been shut down, overall, the season went great, but reminded the Parks Department the importance of the calcium chloride. Mr. Doonan reminded the Commission that the RAC is hoping for LED lights at the Longshore tennis courts. Paddle is going great but continues to have issues with only two courts and multiple teams utilizing them. Some new heaters have been installed with the help of Mike West, and the project should be complete the week of the 12th. Indoor pickleball is going well.

4. To take such action as the meeting may determine to approve fees for the Longshore Sailing School for the 2023 season.

Jane Pimentel was unable to attend due to an emergency. William Coit, Longshore Sailing School General Manager, filled in for her. He explained the rising costs of running the Sailing school, noting the minimum wage increase, inflation, and shipping costs. The Longshore Sailing School discussed proposed fee changes. There was a brief discussion.

Upon a motion by David Floyd, seconded by Matthew Haynes. And passed unanimously 4-0.

RESOLVED: The Parks and Recreation Commission approves the 2023 Fee Schedule for the Longshore Sailing School as submitted.

5. Review of the Longshore Capital Improvement Plan survey and Open House sessions. (Discussion Only)

Gary Sorge of Stantec provided a review of the Open House sessions as well as the results of the accompanying survey. Gary answered questions from the board and from members of the public. There was discussion of creating a hybrid option for Zone 4, and 5.

David Floyd had no additional comments.

7. Administrative Report.

Jennifer Fava stated that she did not have anything to add, having reported all updated information during discussion of agenda items. She did remind everyone of the special Commission meeting scheduled for January 11, 2023, and that the Commission is still scheduled to meet for the regular business meeting on January 18, 2023.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the events as submitted. Charity Golf Tournament fees will be \$2,500 for a half day event and \$4,250 for a double shotgun event.

Resolution Format:

The Parks and Recreation Commission approves the following charity golf outings at Longshore Club Park for the 2023 season subject to dates approved by the Parks and Recreation Director:

Staples High School Gridiron Club VFW Post 399 Westport Police Athletic League Longshore Men's Golf Association Staples Lacrosse Association Children's Community Development Center Staples Rugby Club

The Parks and Recreation Commission approves waiving the golf cart fees and greens fees for the Longshore Men's Golf Association's charity golf tournament (Club House Cup) for 2023.



Usage of Westport Golf Facilities for Fund Raising Tournaments

- 1. The number of fund raising golf tournaments is limited to eight (8) annually.
- 2. A fee to be determined annually by the Parks and Recreation Commission will be charged to the sponsoring organization for each tournament.
- 3. Tournaments must be held on weekday dates, except Tuesdays. Dates will be available in any month, other than those of July and August.
- 4. Sponsoring organizations must be non-profit and be located in Westport or substantially benefiting the Westport community.
- 5. Tournaments should be open to public registration based on availability of space and subject to established entry fees.
- 6. Requests for tournaments shall be submitted in writing, shall be address to the Parks and Recreation Department and must be received **no later than December 15** in the year preceding the requested tournament date.
- 7. Requests shall contain the following information:
 - Name of organization and officer responsible for organizing and supervising the tournament.
 - Date and rain date required.
 - Name(s) of beneficiaries of net income derived from tournament receipts.
 - Approximate number of entrants anticipated and fees to be charged.
 - Proposed expense-revenue operating plan.
 - Anticipated total benefits to be disbursed after expenses.
 - Proposed distribution of proceeds.
- 8. Tournament fee must be paid no later than ten (10) days in advance of tournament play.
- 9. Written accounting of tournament financial results shall be submitted to the Parks and Recreation Department **no later than December 15** following tournament play. Report format to be supplied by Parks and Recreation Department.
- 10. The Parks and Recreation Commission and Parks and Recreation Director will evaluate all proposal received. The ones selected will be voted upon no later than the regular January Commission meeting for tournaments to be held in the calendar year. Final approved dates to be determined by the Parks and Recreation Department. Proposals may be judged on one or more of the following merits:
 - Past experience of the Town with respect to the group.
 - Experience and finances of sponsoring organization.
 - Amount of return of proceeds to benefit local Westport needs.


