In order to qualify for financial assistance or determine eligibility for programs and services, you must provide documentation from the list below. Other programs and resources may not be income-contingent, so please make an appointment with a case worker and bring the appropriate documents to learn about available supports.

To determine eligibility for assistance, please provide the following documents to your case worker:

1. Most recent bank statement for all household members, all accounts – all pages included
2. Four weeks of current and consecutive pay stubs, or unemployment compensation if receiving
3. Child support/Alimony payment document
4. Social Security or disability payment document: 1099 or subsequent document provided by SSA
5. Pension Statement
6. Most recent tax return
7. Mortgage or lease document
8. Utility bills - Gas, Electric, Sewer, Water
9. IRA statements for individuals over 59 ½ years old
10. Any/all Brokerage account statements
11. Any investment and/or retirement statements
