- 1. Most recent bank statement for all household members, all accounts all pages included
- 2. Four weeks of current and consecutive pay stubs, or unemployment compensation if receiving
- 3. Child support/Alimony payment document
- **4.** Social Security or disability payment document: 1099 or subsequent document provided by SSA
- 5. Pension Statement
- 6. Most recent tax return
- 7. Mortgage or lease document
- 8. Utility bills Gas, Electric, Sewer, Water
- 9. IRA statements for individuals over 59 ½ years old
- 10. Any/all Brokerage account statements
- 11. Any investment and/or retirement statements
