1. Upon motion by Andrea Moore, seconded by Jennifer Tooker and passing by a vote of 2-0, it was:

RESOLVED, that the minutes of the Board of Selectwomen's and Water Pollution Control Authority's meeting of February 8, 2023 are hereby APPROVED.

2. Staff Corporal Al D'Amura presented Item #2. Officer D'Amura explained the safety concerns due to parking and pick up at the King's Highway School. The management at Nash's Plaza (175-181 PRW) have installed "Customer Only" signs in the private parking lot, but people continue to park there for student pickup. Further, vehicular parking extending along the Post Road often blocks the entrance to the private parking lot and the intersection itself, causing a traffic hazard. Officer D'Amura praised the principal of King's Highway in notifying parents of the safety concerns and directions for pick-up. The signage will serve as a reminder to drivers. Upon motion by Andrea Moore, seconded by Jennifer Tooker and passing by a vote of 2-0, it was:

RESOLVED, that acting in its capacity as the Local Traffic Authority, and upon the recommendation of Public Safety officials, the request to the CT DOT for the installation of "Do Not Block Driveway" sign(s) on Post Road West at 175-181 Post Road West (Nash's Plaza) and "Do Not Block the Intersection" sign(s) on Post Road West at its intersection at Kings Highway North and is hereby APPROVED.

3. Parks & Recreation Director Jennifer Fava presented Item #3. Ms. Fava said that the Parks & Recreation Commission recommended the fee changes at its February 15 meeting. She stated that the previous increase to the fees was in 2018 and that the nominal increases were a result of additional operating expenses (staffing, supplies, vendors). She also noted that the changes in the fees for non-resident parking passes and the increase in the parking availability was to keep the town in alignment with other comparable communities and maintain accessibility.
