Racquets Advisory Committee – Westport Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes

Monday November 14, 2022

I. Call to order

Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm via Zoom videoconference for the scheduled 30th meeting of the Racquets Advisory Committee ("RAC").

II. Roll call

III. Approval of Minutes from May 17, 2022: minutes were approved

IV. Parks and Recreation Update: (Carmen Roda)

- a) Solid court usage on all fronts.
- b) Working on getting approval to resurface Pickle courts at Compo beach and for a battery operated leaf blower to clean off courts.
- c) Longshore tennis courts will close down in late November/early December weather dependent.

VI. Tennis Discussion

- a) Carmen will work with Mike and Oval Tennis to address calcium chloride treatment schedules.
- b) David Kaplan will follow up with Mike to look into LED lights for the courts and ice rink

- c) Looking into improving reservation system and including Towns Farms courts. Also look to stop people overbooking or not buying handpasses
- d) Carmen was alerted to the fact that the P&R website does not show Towns Farms and Doubleday court availabilities
- e) Carmen will also work to get Bedford ready for indoor play

IX. Longshore Master Plan

a) Group discussion on the different options as proposed in the Longshore Mater Plan. All agreed that as each option involved paddle courts and a hut and new pickle ball courts that we were satisfied that the planning group had listened to our requests.
