I. PUBLIC HEARING

1. **3 Richmondville Avenue / WPL-11690-23;** Application of 3 Richmondville Westport LLC to construct a new in-ground swimming Pool, patio, retaining walls, and associated site improvements. The proposed activity is within the WPL area of Willow Brook.
2. **3 Tupelo Road / WPL-11707-23;** Application of Aleksandra Moch on behalf of the owners, Emily & Lewis Liebert, to construct a new in-ground swimming pool and associated storm water management system. The proposed activity is partially within the WPL area of Dead Man's Brook.
3. **27 Stony Brook Road / WPL-11708-23;** Application of Force Engineering on behalf of the owner, Nansie Bernard, to relocate an existing driveway, walkways, patio, and construct a new ADU, greenhouse, patios, and walkways. The proposed activity is partially within the WPL area of Stony Brook.
4. **17 Wakeman Place / WPL-11710-23;** Application of Gregory Naughton to construct a new floating dock, pier, and walkway. The proposed activity is partially within the WPL area of the Saugatuck River.
5. **17 Grove Point Road / WPL-11712-23;** Application of Kousidis Engineering, LLC, on behalf of the owners, Benjamin G. Joseloff & Taryn M. Allen, to construct a new terrace, deck, and in-ground swimming pool with a patio and associated site improvements. The proposed activity is partially within the WPL area of the Sherwood Mill Pond.
