Animals Update

Lamb socials fully sold out and raised \$17,000 for the Farm

- New Hang with the Gang animal programming to be scheduled beginning in early June
- Reprise of last year's successful Goat Husbandry program is scheduled to begin mid-June with the arrival of two pregnant does on loan from Millmont Farm in Roxbury, CT
- We are in the process of hatching ducks and chickens to add to the flock
- On Thursday May, 4th we celebrated AJ's 20th birthday

Barn Update

- Two meetings have been held with some members of the Historical District Commission (HDC). A final meeting with remaining members will happen prior to May 8
- Official HDC pre-application meeting will be held May 9
- Michael Greenberg has provided the materials list
- The Farm will be sourcing reclaimed wood

Education Update

- Education department is working with the elementary school science teachers to develop a field day curriculum for 1st graders

Farm Report

- The gardens are looking great and planting is underway
- We will be planting 50+ dahlia plants this spring
- Extra large pumpkins have been planted in the new gardens space across the street
- Ridgefield High School interns start the week of May 8
- Farm Stand starts June 10, once a month we will be offering "Farmstead with Friends" where we invite 3-4 outside vendors to join our farmers during Saturday farm stand hours

- Once or twice a month we will be selling tickets to Make Your Own Flower Bouquet classes to be held during Saturday farm stand hours
- Electric all-terrain wheel chair has arrived at the Farm

Pond Project Update

- LandTech proposed a planting plan as well as a plan to eradicate invasive species around the pond
- Water testing to happen late spring with high school interns and LandTech
- A gate to access the pond from outside of the animal enclosure will be added to the fencing the week of May 8
