Roadway Lighting Committee (Illuminating Engineering Society)

Leo Smith has been a voting member of the Illuminating Engineering Society's Roadway Lighting Committee (2006-2020), and served as a member of both its Standard Practice and Residential Street Lighting subcommittees. In 2007 he served as chair of the Roadway Lighting Committee's special task force to determine when roadway lighting may not be necessary.

International Dark Sky Association (IDA)

Leo has been a member of the board of directors of IDA (2004 - 2016) & serves as its Northeast Regional Director for New England, NY and NJ. Chaired of the IDA Public Policy Committee

The Model Lighting Ordinance Task Force was developed over a 7 year period as a joint project between IDA and the Illuminating Engineering Society. Leo was one of the 8 individuals selected for the task force to develop a national recommended practices for outdoor lighting.

Legislation and Agency Regulation

Working with Connecticut legislators, developed draft language used for three Connecticut statutes on street lighting. He developed language used to amend the state building code to reduce light trespass and glare from parking lot lighting.
