## I. PUBLIC HEARING

1. **7 Short Street / WPL-11823-23;** Application of William Kenny Associates LLC, on behalf of the owners, Michael T. Francia & Katherine A. (Halso) Francia, to demolish existing improvements, construct a new single-family residence, driveway, in-ground swimming pool, and associated site improvements and plantings. The proposed activity is partially within the WPL area of the Saugatuck River.

## II. DISCUSSION

Upon completion of the Public Hearing, and time permitting, the Board will consider the following list of discussion topics:

- Prioritize and assist DPW in the approval and implementation of flood related projects involving watersheds in Westport.
- Work with RTM to revise Sec. 30-92. “ Information to be submitted to Flood and Erosion Control Board “ from Article IV - Waterway Protection, while allowing the F&ECB to review large projects if required, and to educate the RTM about what public input related to flooding the Board has received.
- Dedicate a minimum of 2 public discussion meetings per year to discuss updates on flood projects.

- Develop and implement an education campaign to help educate the public about flood and erosion issues in Westport.
- Develop and implement a plan to educate the community on ways to help mitigate the impact of flooding and erosion on private and public properties.
- Advocate for supporting the town mitigation efforts by sharing the Board's perspective with the Board of Finance, state legislative leaders, and DEEP officials.
