Youth Services Report:

- Kevin provided comprehensive updates:
 - Westport Together hosted a screening of the documentary "Like" with the National Charity League (NCL)
 - Well attended for a Sunday and good discussion afterward
 - Westport Together is collaborating with the Staples counseling team for a follow-up discussion on "Never Enough," focusing on parents of athletes.
 - Planning a talk about toxic achievement culture with athletes' parents.
 - Kevin and Detective DelVecchio was part of a joint Westport Prevention Coalition legislative forum with Westport, Wilton, etc., addressing increased prevention work due to changes in cannabis laws.
