Review of 2023 events and requests for 2024 events from sponsoring organizations (PAL review is from 2022 as their event was cancelled in 2023 due to weather). VFW submission includes a letter requesting golf fees be waived.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the events as submitted. Charity Golf Tournament fees will be \$3,000 for a half day event and \$5,000 for a double shotgun event.

Resolution Format:

The Parks and Recreation Commission approves the following charity golf outings at Longshore Club Park for the 2024 season subject to dates approved by the Parks and Recreation Director:

Staples Gridiron Club VFW Post 399 Westport Police Athletic League Friends of Westport Parks & Recreation Staples Lacrosse Association Children's Community Development Center Westport Wreckers Rugby Club

The Parks and Recreation Commission approves waiving the golf cart fees and greens fees for the Friends of Westport Parks & Recreation's charity golf tournament (Club House Cup) for 2024.

Usage of Westport Golf Facilities for Fund Raising Tournaments

- 1. The number of fund raising golf tournaments is limited to eight (8) annually.
- 2. A fee to be determined annually by the Parks and Recreation Commission will be charged to the sponsoring organization for each tournament.
- 3. Tournaments must be held on weekday dates, except Tuesdays. Dates will be available in any month, other than those of July and August.
- 4. Sponsoring organizations must be non-profit and be located in Westport or substantially benefiting the Westport community.
- 5. Tournaments should be open to public registration based on availability of space and subject to established entry fees.
- 6. Requests for tournaments shall be submitted in writing, shall be address to the Parks and Recreation Department and must be received **no later than December 15** in the year preceding the requested tournament date.
- 7. Requests shall contain the following information:
 - Name of organization and officer responsible for organizing and supervising the tournament.
 - Date and rain date required.
 - Name(s) of beneficiaries of net income derived from tournament receipts.
 - Approximate number of entrants anticipated and fees to be charged.
 - Proposed expense-revenue operating plan.
 - Anticipated total benefits to be disbursed after expenses.
 - Proposed distribution of proceeds.
- 8. Tournament fee must be paid no later than ten (10) days in advance of tournament play.
- Written accounting of tournament financial results shall be submitted to the Parks and Recreation
 Department no later than December 15 following tournament play. Report format to be supplied by
 Parks and Recreation Department.
- 10. The Parks and Recreation Commission and Parks and Recreation Director will evaluate all proposal received. The ones selected will be voted upon no later than the regular January Commission meeting for tournaments to be held in the calendar year. Final approved dates to be determined by the Parks and Recreation Department. Proposals may be judged on one or more of the following merits:
 - Past experience of the Town with respect to the group.
 - Experience and finances of sponsoring organization.
 - Amount of return of proceeds to benefit local Westport needs.

Revising Pickleball Handpass to be Consistent with Other Racquet Sports

Handpasses

While discussing the handpass fees as part of the January 17, 2024, Parks and Recreation Commission meeting it was requested that we have further discussion related to the changes from the Pickleball pass to the Pickleball Handpass that was approved at that meeting. The Department feels it is important to clarify and make the requirements and entitlements consistent.

Due to the increase in use and feedback from the Racquets Advisory Committee and customers about people monopolizing courts, it is important for us to take a consistent approach to the use of all our racquet sports facilities. This also serves as a way to give residents priority over our facilities.

Additionally, as part of a department review it was determined that people were misusing the system and cross booking reservations when they did not have such privileges. As part of the upgrade to the court reservation system, it no longer allows for booking reservations with telephone numbers or cross booking.

Attached is a Handpass Breakdown, which indicates the various available handpass categories and the privileges that accompany each type of handpass. In general terms, any handpass allows access to the pools and courts and the specific type of handpass may provide fee entitlements and the capability of making a reservation for that particular handpass type up to five (5) days in advance.

The one exception is the Compo Beach pickleball courts where a handpass is not required to use them but is necessary if making a reservation for those courts. This exception is to allow any user of Compo Beach access to this amenity, just as they have with the other amenities within the property (excluding the marina).

Therefore, the department requests to change the Handpass policy to read as follows: A Parks and Recreation Handpass is required for resident privileges related to the use of the Town of Westport's golf, tennis, platform tennis, pickleball, Longshore Pool and Staples Pool facilities.
