- Unfortunately, we lost both bee hives over the winter. New bees are due to arrive in early March and early April. We are planning on 4-5 hives.
- We are starting to review applications for the Senior Internship program. This year we will only be taking 8 seniors from Staples High School.
- We are currently boiling Maple sap. A public demonstration is scheduled for Saturday, March

- An ADA approved bathroom has been added to the plans for the Wakeman Barn renovation project, as well as an addition of a gardening slop sink
- Waiting on finalized drawings for septic system from LandTech to submit to the Health Department for approval
- The project will include a new driveway
- A new walkway from Wakeman Farm Drive to the Farm gate is also under consideration
- The Barn committee is presenting finalized plans to the ZBA in April followed by a 30-day RFP process
- Construction is now targeted to begin in late September, after Harvest Fest
- Funds for the project do not include costs for the interior build out of the barn
