IT Department Overview

Highlights from EZ's presentation and Q&A

- IT delivers secure, reliable, cost-effective services that are accessible, mobile, connected
- System offers redundancy, high availability, high capacity, security and speed
- #1 priority is security - town owned dark fiber ring network plus
- A mostly cloud based system with sufficient back up,
- A vast digital service catalog that serves several areas of town govt & the public
- Incl watching town mtgs, registering to vote, sign ups for P&R programs, paying taxes, etc.
- System includes a mobile ready town website that delivers all services to the public
- An online Geographic Information System (GIS) - (Westport is an early adopter of this)
- A digital marketing effort to showcase Westports attributes and offerings
- IT is a cost effective area - 3 FTEs, outsourcing, efficient operations
- It is service oriented and "back office" in nature
- Challenges incl increasing complexity, cybersecurity, cost control, maintaining skilled workforce
- There is 0 margin for error (during Covid all shut down, but IT kept govt going)

Communications Improvements

Highlights from discussion about other communications ideas and next steps

- Some improvements are already taking place - more recorded mtgs, some newsletters
- Other ideas discussed: RTM newsletters, fireside chats, podcasts, high school visits, plus:
- Website improvements - updated/improved content, better organization/navigation, & add AI
- Darrell noted [How Do I...](#) plus [Navigation Tips](#) on the website and outside google searches are good ways to help find Town website based info and services
- It was noted while IT manages town tech incl website, Town departments need to provide content for their areas of responsibility
- We agreed to add to the list and at next mtg prioritize & designate 1-3 items to address
- Important: with any improvement recommendations, we need to consider appropriateness for government entity, compliance, cost and staff implications.
