Westport Golf Advisory Committee Draft Meeting Minutes June 3, 2024

The Golf Advisory Committee of the Town of Westport conducted a Zoom meeting on Monday, April 1, 2024. The meeting was called to order by GAC chairperson, Jane Dally at 7:00p.m.

Members Present: Jane Dally, Mike Durkin, Rich Raphael, and John Ehli. Not present were Irla Landry and Corey Miller.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the April 1 meeting passed unanimously.

Public Comments

No public comments.

Presidents Reports

9 Holers – President Anne Haymon reported the league held its John Janik tournament on May 30 after it was postponed a week due to rain. The Member-Guest tournament will be next week with a luncheon at La Plage. Everyone is enjoying the fine course conditions.

LWGA 18 holers – Cynthia Carpenter reported for President Sue Roberts. 124 members have registered for the new season. Twenty of those women are new members.

The George Buck match play championship was completed and Chris Lorusso is the 2024 winner.

The President's Cup (the second major of the year) is now underway with the final round on Tuesday, June 11.

Short Game clinics with Jon Janik have been very popular.

The Member-Guest is set for August 20. Registration is on Leaderboard starting July 10. A Seminar sponsored by ONS will be held at the library on July 12.

LMGA – Ryan Smith reported that the league has 422 members with a target of 455.

All Spring events are now complete

Six one-day events have been completed so far. All fields have been full with wait lists.

The Member-Member and Member-Guest will be played in July and the Club Championship is in August.

Administrator Report

Rick Giunta spoke on behalf of Parks & Recreation

The course had 5,486 rounds in May, down 5.2% over last year. We had a very rainy May. No update on the tee improvement project.

No update on the clubhouse project. The project has been placed on the 10 year capital plan but no further progress has been made. He understands that the GAC is willing to be very involved in moving this process along.

Superintendent Report

Sean Charles reported that although he is understaffed, the golf course work is at full speed. He is finalizing the bunker repair and resodding on holes 1,3,5,8 and 11. The current plan is to keep bunker surrounds mowed and fescue low until later in the summer to encourage turf growth and assist with weed control. Bunkers will remain a focus with maintenance and adding new sand as necessary. We currently use Valley Forge Buff, some of the best sand in the industry.

Sean's maintenance plan is to prepare the course for upcoming "hot" months.

The seasonal staff will be coming aboard shortly to cover the summer months.

New ball washers have been ordered for holes on the back nine.

Golf Pro Report

Jon Janik reported that the pro shop has been busy and all merchandise is in.

Staples Rugby held their event on May 13 with 84 players. Staples Grid Iron held their event on June 3 with 94 players. The Y's Men held an outing with 40 players.

The Jr. Golf program successfully completed May classes. Summer classes are all full and will begin in a few weeks.

The Ladies clinics have been successful.

GAC Comments

Cynthia Carpenter commented on the Butterfly Garden behind the Halfway House and said it looks great. She had questions about the milkweek growing behind the 16th green. Sean is not planning to spray there.

Rick Guinta confirmed early in the meeting that the public is notified about the GAC meetings on the town website and any interested individuals can sign up for email notifications to receive meeting notices.

The Zoom meeting ended at 7:44p.m.
