LEGAL NOTICE AND AGENDA WESTPORT CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING SEPTEMBER 11, 2024

Notice is hereby given of a Public Hearing of the Westport Conservation Commission pursuant to the Connecticut Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Act, and the Regulations for the Protection and Preservation of Inland Wetlands and Watercourses of the Town of Westport (IWW Regulations) and the Waterway Protection Line Ordinance (WPLO) to be held on **Wednesday, September 11, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of Westport Town Hall.**

The Commission shall meet to take such action under the purview of the Town's IWW Regulations and the Waterway Protection Line Ordinance as the meeting may determine with regard to the following:

Changes or Additions to the Agenda: The Commission may amend the agenda by a 2/3 vote to include items not requiring a Public Hearing.

Public Hearing: 7:00 p.m. The following applications will be "received" by the Conservation Commission subject to determination of completion. If applications are determined to be complete the Commission will proceed by opening the hearing. (At this time interested parties may be heard after being recognized by the Chairman. Written communication may be received for all applications until the public hearing is closed.)

- 1. 8 Pond Edge Road: Application #IWW/M-11986-24 by Curt Lowenstein of LandTech on behalf of Ana & Eric Cantor to amend wetland boundary map # D05.
- 2. 11 Edgemarth Hill Road: Application #IWW-11973-24 by Andy Soumelidis of LandTech on behalf of Venti LLC for a proposed two lot subdivision.
- **3. 5 Quentin Road:** Application #WPL-11978-24 by Andra Vebell & Larry Hoy for proposed pool and patio. Work is within the WPLO area of the Saugatuck River.
- **4. 10 Beltas Farm Lane:** Application #IWW,WPL/E-11987-24 by Fairfield County Contractors LLC to construct a new single family residence, driveway, pool, septic system, drainage, and associated site improvements. Portions of the work are within the upland review area setbacks.
- 5. 12 Beltas Farm Lane: Application #IWW,WPL/E-11987-24 by Fairfield County Contractors LLC on behalf of Belta's Farm Legacy LLC to construct a new single family residence, driveway, pool, septic system, drainage, and associated site improvements. Portions of the work are within the upland review area setbacks.
