Sculpture Update:

Dina reported on her meeting with Mark Zarif. His work, Enzo, that interested WAAC for Eloise Ray Park is currently on exhibit in Massachusetts. We will need to inspect it before installation at Eloise Ray Park. Our interest is in Babette Block's work for Canal Green Park. We will meet with the artist, Parks and Rec and Public Works on Monday

Sept 16 at 3pm to discuss the sculptures' siting. Once the site at each park has been approved, recommendations will be sent to the Parks and Rec Commission and then the First Selectwomen for final sign off.

Charles Rosoff made a Motion to recommend the installation of the two sculptures one at Canal Green Park and one at Eloise Ray Park as long as the artist met all conditions and there is approval from the Town. Richard Epstein seconded.

All were in favor, with Kathie Bennewitz abstaining.

Kathie Bennewitz reported that Anne Boberski along with Ive Covici, WestPAC cochairs, will be the reps at WAAC meetings. Agenda and minutes are to be sent to both.

The Cartoon show opened at the library; all work is on loan from the Town Collection. WestPAC has also lent work to the Fairfield Museum and History Center and the Bellarmine Museum of Art at Fairfield University for their current exhibitions. West PAC will be curating an exhibition of work from the Town Collection at MoCA/CT. The opening is on January 16, 2025
