The Golf Advisory Committee of the Town of Westport conducted a Zoom meeting on Monday, August 5, 2024. The meeting was called to order by GAC chairperson, Jane Dally at 7:00p.m.

Members Present: Jane Dally, Mike Durkin, Rich Raphael, Corey Miller and Irla Landry. Not present was John Ehli.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the June 3 meeting passed unanimously.

Public Comments

No public comments.

Presidents Reports

9 Holers – President Anne Haymon reported the league has had a busy summer of tournaments. Upcoming is the Back Nine and the George Buck Championship.

LWGA 18 holers – Sue Roberts reported that the Club Championship wrapped up last week with Jennifer Cole as the overall winner and Shawn Bray as Runner-Up.

The annual Lobster Fest was a huge success once again with over 50 members attending at the Longshore marina. Westfair Fish & Chips catered and there was a live band.

The Member-Guest is set for August 20. Homes For Hope will be this year's beneficiary. The Angela Aulenti Fall Cup will be the final major of the season.

The course had 6,496 rounds in July up 1% from last year this time.

No update on the clubhouse project. The project has been placed on the 10 year capital plan but no further progress has been made.

No update on the hiring of a new P&R Director.

Superintendent Report

Sean Charles reported that the golf course is in good condition and has held up well in the extreme heat. He is hoping to introduce Bentgrass into the fairways over time. He is adding sand on a regular basis.

He continues to trim the fescue to rid it of weeds. He will allow the fescue to grow back.

Cooler night time temps will help take some stress off the turf.

Ropes and cart signs were removed on hole 8 and unless Sean notices damage near the green from cart traffic he would like to leave it open without signs or rope.

The Tee leveling program has been pushed to the Fall 2025.

Golf Pro Report

Jon Janik reported that rounds are busy and the tee sheet is full every day.

Recent tournaments held at Longshore include the VFW and the Met PGA Junior.

Junior golf classes are now completed

Weekday summer classes are full

The shop has a good supply of golf balls so he invites everyone to stop by to purchase balls.

GAC Comments

Rich Raphael reported that the course is the best it has been in recent years. He thanked Sean for his great work.

Cory Miller asked about the tee time system and why we can't add credit card information so the "no shows" can be billed and that would open up the tee sheet for same day slots.

The town's Tee Time system has been a discussion point for many years and Jon would like to use the same one being used at Smith-Richardson. Chairwoman Jane Dally will work with Jon to get a new system in place for 2025.
