- New special education classes for Neurodivergent Children, lead by Paraprofessional LeAnn Duggan and an assistant, began on Saturday Oct 5th. There are two sessions (ages 3-11 and 11+) available that can accommodate 8 children, and their caregivers, per session. Some spots are still available and will be prorated for the remaining three weeks.
- A second 4-week session of the special education class is planned for early December
- The Farm has held no cost programming for several local organizations including Help 4 Kids, ABC House, and Homes with Hope, as part of a new Community Outreach program.
