The Westport Center for Senior Activities (WCSA) is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for adults 60 years of age and older by offering the opportunity to continue to learn and develop; to maintain optimum physical, mental, and social well-being; and to enjoy recreation and companionship in a pleasant and safe environment.

The WCSA is a 15,375 square foot building located in a tranquil 22.4 acre park known as the Baron's Park South; parking is free. The facility offers an updated, expanded fitness center with a full complement of exercise equipment with restrooms and showers, art rooms, game rooms, meeting/conference rooms, a library and additional activity rooms. The facility offers a full-service kitchen, serving hot lunches prepared on-site by our own chef Monday – Friday for a nominal donation of \$5-\$7.00. We also have a Grab & Go concession offering hot and cold beverages, healthy snacks and light lunch options for those on the go. The WCSA offers a large multi-purpose media room, game room with pool table and fireplace, arts and crafts rooms, and a health screening room – all in a beautiful, warm and inviting environment.
